Our flying site is located at 14501 N. Old Galena Road, just north of the Caterpillar Technical Center. From the intersection of old Galena Road and Cedar Hills Drive, drive about one mile north, our sign is on the West side of the road, turn left (West) at the power lines. The field is about 1/4 mile on your right. See the map on next panel.

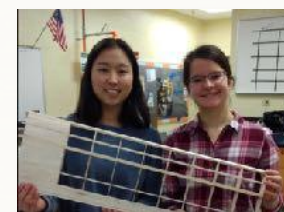
